WHO WE ARE: In 1954, on Chicago's near west side, a new civic organization called Pilsen Neighbors Community Council (PNCC) emerged as Eastern European immigrants banded together to confront their community's most pressing needs. In the late sixties and early seventies, the Pilsen neighborhood underwent a major demographic change with a dramatic influx of newly arriving immigrants from Mexico. These new arrivals transformed the Pilsen community and PNCC was reinvigorated by the new group of residents and switched from providing social services to a more vocal, organizing engine. PNCC works on Education Reform, Immigration Reform, Workforce development, Universal Healthcare and works to empower neighboring churches, schools and works with other organizations to fulfill its mission of establishing policies and practices in the Greater Pilsen Area.
