Pilsen Unites for Peace March Against Gang Violence

(Chicago, IL) On Monday June 25, 2012, Pilsen Neighbors Community Council's Public Safety Task Force will organize a peace march against gang violence. The march will include more than 100 community residents such as parents, youth, educators and activists in attempts for a peaceful summer in Pilsen.

Where: Begins at the St. Procopius Church Garden (1641 South Allport Street)

Time: 6:30 pm March take-off. 6:50 pm March ends.

The 12th District Acting Commander, Ronald A. Pontecore will make an announcement about the enforcement of Curfew Law, preceding a mass outside.

On May 8th 2012, more than one hundred residents came together at Dvorak Park in Pilsen to demand public safety and on Monday June 25th the community will once again unite against gang violence by marching side by side with:
